



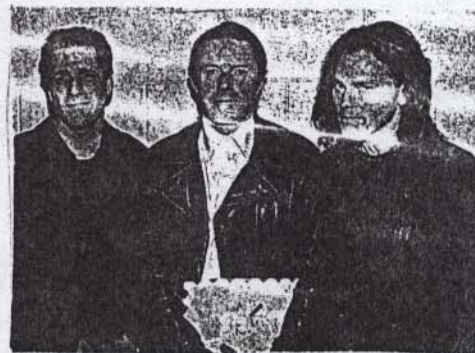
Don Henley and Glenn Frey at a benefit for MUJATH (musicians joined at the hip).
