LIVE IN CONCERT

Only one band can lay claim to more than 120 million album sales worldwide, five number one albums, four Grammy Awards, and five number one singles. Only one band in musical history has had three albums sell more than ten million units and received certification from the United States' RIAA for the best selling album of all time (*Greatest Hits 1971-1975*).

Only a handful of acts have been inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in their first year of eligibility. And even fewer are accorded a Grammy nomination for a brand new single (*Hole In The World*) thirty-one years after their very first hit.

And while audiences in the United States have recently been delighted by the Eagles live, it has been almost ten long years since the band last toured Australia with the enormous sell-out success of their *Hell Freezes Over Tour*.

So it is with some pageantry that The Frontier Touring Company announces the upcoming Australian leg of the Eagles' **Farewell I Tour**. Touring Perth, Melbourne, Sydney and Brisbane, this is without doubt one of the most anticipated tours for 2004.

Since their last tour to Australia the Eagles have added yet another impressive addition to their already considerable discography. Since its release in late 2003 *The Complete Greatest Hits* (in stores now) is already nearing Gold status, adding to the substantial 3.4 million total album sales solely within this country. Their *Hell Freezes Over* DVD remains the best ever selling music DVD in Australian history.

In light of the continued popularity of the *Hell Freezes Over* DVD, promoter Michael Gudinski expects that the Farewell I tour will deliver everything Australian Eagles fans could desire. In a concert lasting up to three hours in length, fans will be treated to a set list which truly defines the expression "greatest hits".

"This was truly one of the most awesome shows I've seen," Gudinski said of the Farewell I show he saw in Boston.

"It totally blew my mind. Thirty years of hits across three hours. I defy anyone to say they left that show disappointed."

And the critics concur, with *Chartattack* in the US declaring of one of the band's October 2003 concert, "The Eagles offered all the classics from its three-decade-old discography...the hits just kept coming." While the *Omaha World-Herald* wrote of the May 16 concert, "Don Henley, Glenn Frey, Joe Walsh and Timothy B. Schmit were vocally and instrumentally superb." While the *Grand Rapids Press* wrote, "Eagles extraordinaire... legends of American rock deliver it tight, just right."

The set is simplicity itself, with a relatively bare stage and a huge wall of video screens. To the left and right of the stage two giant screens ensure that even those in the very back row don't miss a moment of the on stage action. The sheer lack of adornment allows fans to focus on what they're all there to experience – the music that has made the Eagles the legends they are today.

The pre-sale will conclude on Friday 18th June at 10.00am AEST.

The public on-sale will commence on Monday 21 June at 9.00am local time.
